



CHANGES TO THE 2011/2012 YEAR END AWARD REQUIREMENTS

EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY (UNLESS OTHERWISE NOTED)

Note: Changes effective immediately were deemed by the ADA Board of Directors to be enhancements in the program that would not have an impact on awards program qualifying.

ADA Recognized Competition Award (Formerly: High Point Award)

- **Change:** Requires 3 scores from 3 different judges (*lowered from 5 scores from 4 judges*),
- **Omit:** divisions being combined if less than 3.

ADA Schooling Competition Award (Formerly: High Point Award)

- **Change:** Requires 3 scores from 3 different judges (*lowered from 6 scores*), "L" graduate or higher, etc...
- **Omit:** divisions being combined if less than 3.

Rider Achievement Award

- **Add:** participant chooses Rider Achievement or Outstanding Award (below), not both.

*NEW Award for 2011: Outstanding Award

- Requires 3 scores of 70% or better from 3 different judges; etc... same as Rider Achievement.
- Participant chooses Rider Achievement or Outstanding Award, not both.
- Horse Owners Name near Rider and Horse names.

*CHANGES for 2012:

- ADA Recognized and Schooling Competition Award Champion Horse and Rider Combination may only win the award one time (*previously no limit*).
- ADA Recognized and Schooling Competition Awards Training thru 4th level, scores will require one test be from test 3 of the level. For Introductory level one score must be from test B (*previously test not specified*).
- ADA Recognized Competition Award: 2 scores (*increased from 1*) must be from an ADA sponsored Competition; Championship etc...
- ADA Schooling Competition Award: 2 scores (*previously no requirement*) must be from a schooling show on the ADA calendar (show does not have to be sponsored by ADA).
