USDF Medal Recipient Bronze Silver Gold

In order for a competitor to be eligible for year-end awards they must complete at least 3 volunteer hours to the club. This requirement may be done by the competitor or someone else appointed by the competitor in their stead. These hours may include 3 hours of volunteer time at shows (ADA rated shows or ADA recognized schooling shows), clinics or other club sponsored events. These hours may also be completed by getting sponsorships/ads for the club. Each \$50 worth of sponsorship/ads are equal to 1 volunteer hour. These hours must be completed no later than November 20th of awards year. **I have completed a minimum of three volunteer hours**
