#### **Divisions:**

- Adult Amateur (AA): A rider age 21\* and over who does not receive remuneration for instructing or coaching riders, or training or riding horses.
- Junior- Under 13\*: A rider under age 13.
- Junior – 13 and over\*: A rider between the ages of 13 and 20.
- Open: Any rider who does not fall in the Adult Amateur or Junior divisions.

*\*Junior riders who turn 13 or 21 during the qualifying year may compete in the division they were eligible for at the beginning of the qualifying year.*

**Location:** In the Irons Equestrian Center, 25785 Boerne Stage Rd. San Antonio, Texas 78015, 210-698-5270.

**Arenas:** Competition - sand footing with enclosed fencing. Warm-up – Adjacent arena with sand footing.

**Lunging:** Is permitted in warm up arena.

**Stabling:** Limited day stalls are available.

**Awards:** Ribbons 1<sup>st</sup> through 6<sup>th</sup> place. High Point Champion & Reserve for each level and division awarded to the horse and rider combination who score the highest percentage scores of that level and division. Minimum of 2 riders in a level or division required. Overall High Point and Reserve High Point of show.

**Show Time:** Show office will open 1 hour before the show start time.

**Entries:** Entries must be mailed to Secretary, postmarked by February 17, 2012. Checks payable to "ADA". Current (within 12 months) negative COGGINS is required for every entry.

#### **Fees:**

**Ride times:** Ride times will be e-mailed before 5:00pm Friday before the show.

**Concessions:** Coffee, water and light snacks available for purchase.

**Dogs:** Dogs must be on a leash.

**Refunds:** Refunds after closing date (except class fees) are possible in the event of a death in the family or if rider provides a doctor's or veterinarian certificate indicating they or their mount cannot compete. Class fees can also be refunded in these situations only if the show is over subscribed.

Management reserves the right to cancel or combine classes, change officials, or refuse entries. Informal attire, boots or half-chaps and **ASTM approved helmets are mandatory** for all riders. USEF/USDF rules will be followed with regards to tack and helmets.
